Archival Research Policy

The Guy B. Woodward Museum's archives are available to the public for research. You **must** reserve a research date and time. Persons using museum records for purposes of research will agree to have a museum archivist present during the course of the research. A declaration as to the purpose of the research will be made on our "Records of Archival Research" form and no records, books, documents, or other artifacts can be removed from the museum grounds. Special arrangements must be made if more than one person is doing the research. Call our office at 760-789-7644 to make arrangements to do research.

The museum charges for research time and the duplication of materials from the archives according to the following schedule.

If research is being done for purposes of profit, the cost will be \$50.00 - \$100.00 for the four hour period. This cost covers the time required for the museum's archivist to research and secure the necessary materials and to monitor the research.
